The aim of the Conference is to provide a platform for young Moscow University researchers to present the results of their research and development activities in life sciences.

As an interdisciplinary and interfaculty conference, it encompasses a wide range of topics within the domain of life sciences in order to bring together students of biology and other related disciplines.

Delegates are welcome to present their research activities and innovative ideas in one of the following sections:

- **General biology**
- **Biochemistry and molecular biology**
- **Genetics, embryology, histology**
- **Bioengineering and biophysics**
- **Physiology and neurobiology**
- **Ecology**

The working language of the conference is English. It will be used for all presentations, discussions and printed materials.

Each paper presentation will last for 20 minutes (10 mins presentation and 10 mins Q&A). All the accepted abstracts will be published on respective faculties' websites.

Abstracts of the best papers will be published in the Conference proceedings (ISBN, RINC).

Submission for the Conference

Each paper proposal should include a title and an extended abstract of 350-400 words long (excluding references). The abstract should specify research questions and hypothesis,

approach, method, data and (expected) results.

All submissions will be evaluated by the members of the Program Committee with the relevant expertise on the basis of relevance to conference objectives, background information overview, research design and methods used, as well as clarity of language and presentation of questions/hypothesis posed.
