With a deep regret I have to inform you that Professor Oleg Petrii of the Moscow State University passed away on July 30. Oleg Petrii was a Frumkin's student and one of the leaders of soviet electrochemical school.

His contributions to the development of interfacial electrochemistry throughout his career are outstanding and diverse. He started from experimental verification of Frumkin correction and later pioneered electrocatalysis on Pt-Ru electrodes. He was also well known for thermodynamics of perfectly polarizable electrode, which he developed jointly with Frumkin in 60s and 70s.

Oleg Petrii was Frumkin memorial medal winner in 2009.

We all shall remember Oleg Petrii as a faithful friend, a person with great erudition, humor and spirit.
