RULES FOR SUBMISSION OF ARTICLES for the journal «Moscow University

Chemistry Bulletin» (published on the website www.chem.msu.su/rus/vmgu/)

The journal **«Moscow University Chemistry Bulletin»** publishes articles and bibliographic reviews on various branches of chemistry, comes out once every two months. When reprinting, a reference to the journal is required.

Requirements for the design of articles

Microsoft Word text editor; Times New Roman Cyrillic font (12 point size); One and a half line spacing. When naming chemical compounds, use IUPAC terminology. All abbreviations must be deciphered. All formulas and lettering should be printed with clear marking of all the features of the text (indexes, bold, italics, etc.).

Formulas. To type formulas, you should use the MathType program, font (for typing the main text of formulas, 11 point is used, for a set of indices - 8, Latin should be typed in italics). Mixed use of Russian and Latin indices in one article should be avoided. Indexes are subject to decoding in the text.

Tables are numbered in the order of their mentioning in the text in Arabic numerals. The number should be followed by the name of the table. All columns in tables and tables themselves must have titles and be separated by vertical lines. Abbreviations of words in tables are not allowed. Line-by-line digital material should be clearly marked with horizontal lines.

Drawings. Each drawing should be made in TIF format, preferably each drawing on a separate sheet. All figures must be signed.

Bibliography. All references are given in the original language and are numbered. Names in Japanese, Chinese, and other languages using non-Latin script are written in Latin script. A bibliographic reference in the text should be in the form of a serial number in square brackets and follow strictly in order. Citation of two or more works under the same number, the same work under different numbers is not allowed. Links to books translated into Russian must be accompanied by links to the original editions with an indication of the imprint. Links to journals should contain the following information: surnames and initials of all authors, title of the journal, year, volume, number, page. Links to books should contain the following information: authors, title of work, title of collection (conference, symposium), city (location), year, volume, number.

Requirements for the form of submission of articles

Rich text format (RTF),. The article must contain the following mandatory elements: a) UDC;

b) the title of the article in Russian and English, the names of the authors in Russian and English.c) the name of the institution (department) in Russian and English;

d) annotation (3-5 sentences), keywords (3-6 words / phrases) in Russian and English;

e) information about all authors (at the very end of the article): last name, first name, patronymic

(in full), academic degree, academic title, full name of the scientific or educational institution and its structural unit, e-mail address of all authors;

f) the list of cited works should be drawn up in the form of a list of references.

Procedure for submission and review of articles

Articles in electronic form are sent to the editorial office or the deputy editor-in-chief of the journal: vestnik_mgu@mail.ru or melnikov46@mail.ru. All received works are sent for reviewing. Reviews containing comments are sent to the authors for their removal. After recommending the work for publication, the authors submit to the editorial office of the journal (by e-mail vestnik_mgu@mail.ru, or room 129a of the Faculty of Chemistry of Smorodinskaya Zh.Ya) a scan of the examination certificate on the possibility of publishing the article in the open press. A scan of the license agreement is sent to the journal's email address. (The paper version can be brought to room 129a. Or sent by mail to the address: Moscow 119991, Leninskie gory 1, building 3, Faculty of Chemistry, Moscow State University, room 129a, Zh.Ya. Smorodinskaya)

Other. There is no payment of royalties for publications. There is no fee for the publication of manuscripts. The full-text issues of the journal are posted on the website of the Faculty of Chemistry of Moscow State University www.chem.msu.ru 6 months after the publication of their printed versions and the table of contents of the current issues of the journal. On the site www.chem.msu.su/rus/vmgu/ there is a sample 1 / d and a new section "addition" has appeared, which must be viewed.
